However, the Free E-mail and Text Message Alerts service cannot provide immediate notice of events and is not a substitute for active management of your accounts and other credit union services. You may experience errors, interruptions, delays or failures in the receipt of your Free E-mail and Text Message Alerts for a variety of reasons, which may include technical difficulties suffered by Schofield Federal Credit Union or your Internet service provider or wireless communications carrier. If you choose to have your Alerts delivered to your cell phone or certain other devices, a portion of the Alert, or related information and disclaimers, may be omitted due to space limitations or technological considerations. Schofield Federal Credit Union is not responsible for any charges from your wireless service provider.

You are responsible for providing complete and accurate contact information to Schofield Federal Credit Union for the purpose of receiving the Alerts. You are also responsible for promptly updating such information in the event of any change in your e-mail address, cell phone number or other identified means of contact.

We currently provide the E-mail and Text Message Alerts service to our members at no additional charge. However, we reserve the right, at any time, to begin charging a fee for the E-mail and Text Message Alerts service or to impose other limitations on its use. You will be notified of any such change in advance.
